

Roman Fress (born in Kazakhstan, based in Germany) retained his WBC International Cruiserweight title via a KO after 1:17 in round 9 against Stefan Nikolic (born in Sweden, based in Austria).

It was a hard hook to the liver delivered by Fress to stop Nikolic for the count.

It was a close fight, draw after 4 rounds.

Anssi Perajoki (Finland) had it even after 8 rounds.

Fabian Guggenheim (Switzerland) and Alexander Walter (Germany) had Fress winning by a close margin.

The referee was Massimo Barrovecchio (Italy).

The two fighters had faced each other in their Amateur career when Nikolic was able to beat Fress during an International tournament.

WBC #19 Roman Fress retained his WBC International 200lbs title with the win.
