Current Situation about the WBC International titles up to October 30th

Heavyweight Andrii Novytski (Ukraine)

Novytski won the vacant WBC International title last July 27th in Melrose (Boston US).

Last September 20th in Melrose (US) Andrii outpointed Shawn Laughery in a non-title bout to improve to 13-0, 10.

Silver champion Mourad Aliev (France)

Mourad scored an easy win last September 7th in Köln (Germany) in a non-title bout

Bridgerweight title vacant

Tyson Pedro vs Kris Terzievski ... an endless series of circumstances caused continuous postponements. The championship should now take place in Penrith (Australia) next November 13th or 20th. More to come..

Silver title Davide Brito (Italy)

Köln (Germany) last September 7th: Davide Brito outpointed Ali Kiydin to win the vacant belt.

Cruiserweight Roman Fress (born in Kazakhstan)

Roman Fress is on the line to defend his crown next November 2nd in Germany.

Silver champion Yusuf Sultanoglu (Germany-Turkey)

Lightheavy Ezra Taylor (UK)

After winning the vacant title last July, Ezra Taylor was scheduled to make his first defence in Birmingham next November 2nd, but the fight was eventually switched to a non-title bout.

Silver title Branimir Malenica (Germany)

Branimir scored an easy win last September 7th in Köln (Germany) in a non-title bout and will defend his belt during our Annual Convention in Hamburg.

Supermiddle Luka Plantic (Croatia)

Luka Plantic retained his title last September 7th in Köln against Catalin Paraschiveanu (KO3) and will face Silver champ Bulacio next November 15th in London.

Silver champion Martin Ezequiel Bulacio (Argentina)

Serhat Güler surprisingly lost his Silver belt last September 12th in London when his challenger Bulacio stopped hin in round seven. He will now fight Plantic as reported above.

Middleweight Fiodor Czerkaszyn (born in Ukraine – based in Poland)

Fiodor Czerkaszyn outclassed southpaw Sebastian Horacio Papeschi (Argentina) last October 26th in Zakopane to win this vacant crown.

Silver title vacant

Samuel Nmomah relinquished the silver belt on voluntary basis. The vacant championship scheduled to happen during our Annual Convention in Hamburg.

Superwelterweight Ermal Hadribeaj (Albania)

The champion retained his crown last September 7th in Köln (Germany) against previously unbeaten Younes Zarraa. He will defend his belt again during our Annual Convention in Hamburg.

Silver champion Stephen McKenna (Ireland)

Unbeaten Stephen McKenna (Ireland) won the vacant Silver belt in a dramatic fight against Joe Laws (UK) last August 3rd in Barnsley (UK). Promoted by BOXXER of Ben Shalom, the vacant title bout saw both fighters visiting the canvas in the first round. Laws won the sencond round, but McKenna dropped him twice in round three and the referee decided that enough was enought after the loser was floored for the third time in the same session (cornerman threw in the towel).

Michael McKinson was stripped and the vacant title bout will be in Italy next November 16th in Milan (Italy): Akrem Aouina vs Nicholas Esposito.

Jack Rafferty stopped defending champ Henry Turner last October 5th in Liverpool to win this Silver belt.
